Installation

- 1. Screw the brackets to the bottom of the speakers.
- 2. Find a safe, ideal mounting location and fit the brackets over the chosen mounting bars.
- 3. Fasten the mounting screws after you review the safety of the mounting location.

Wiring

- 1. Be sure to run the wiring securely and far away from any moving components.
- Connecting the power cable to the power source: You will need to connect the 12V red wire to a (fused 2A) switched power source.
- 3. Use the 3.5mm stereo jack to connect to your entertainment source(MP3 player, etc).
- 4. Use your player device and wired remote volume controller to control your level of loudness.

To pair and connect your Bluetooth device to the MC425BA Enter Settings > Blueboth Menu > Search > "MC425BA" > If Prompted to enter a passcode enter: "0000"


